SAFFRON INDIAN BISTRO TUCSON, ARIZONA

The focus for the interior of this 3,123 square foot bistro was to combine ethnic recipes with a contemporary and lively atmosphere which could transform from an airy and delightful daytime feel to a warmer, more intimate setting at night.

One of the challenges was to separate the lunch buffet function (without hiding it) from the more upscale dinner crowd. The dilemma was solved by using a colorful and light fabric panel arrangement dividing the Buffet and Dining Room.

A variety of materials and textures as well as rhythm derived from the reoccurring elements create interest in the space. A bold but simple color scheme of cream and various shades of saffron infused by the multiple lighting elements radiate warmth and invite patrons to linger and enjoy great food and company.
